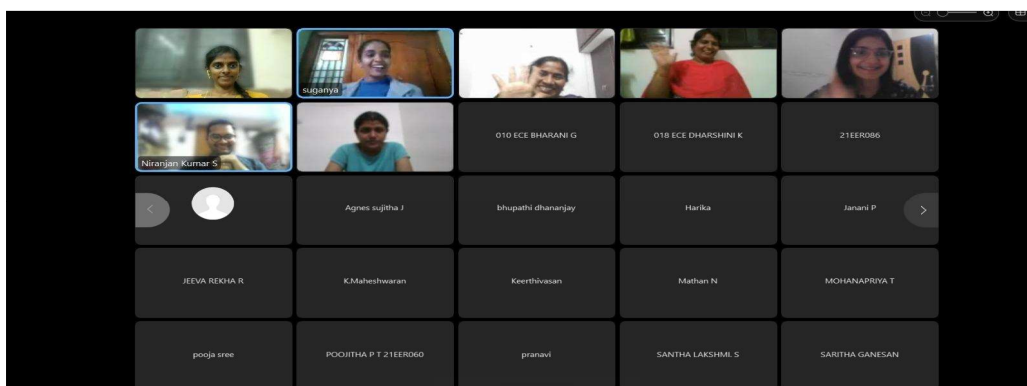
Nurturing Growth Mindset

"Maathare" - Women's Day Special Seminar

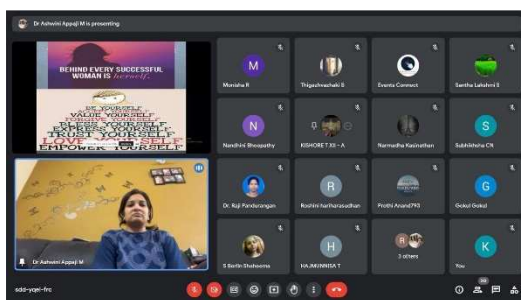

Webinar on Women Empowerment

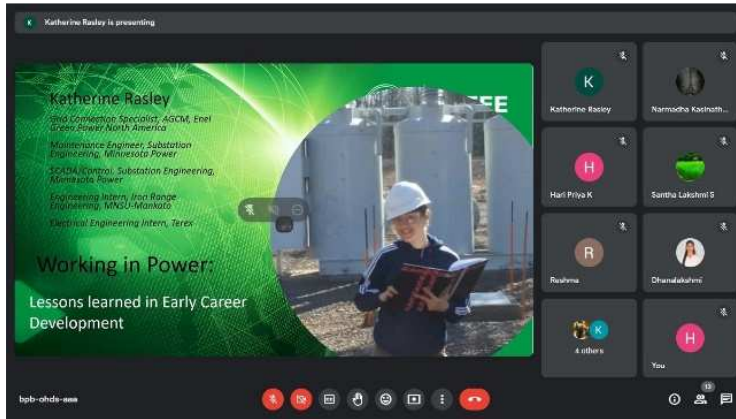

Webinar On Working in Power: Lessons learned in Early Career Development

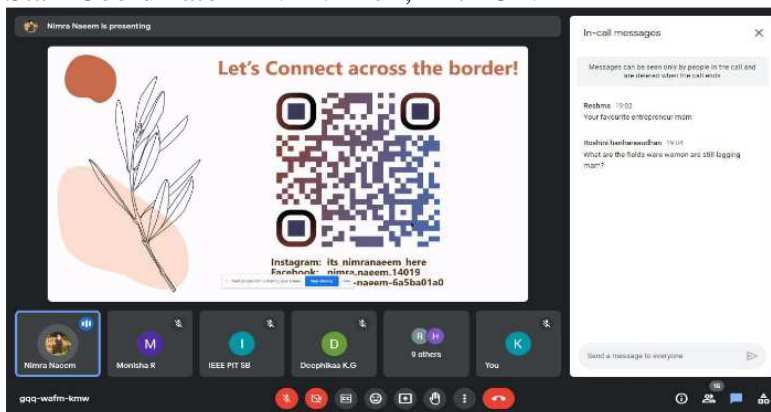

SAKHI 2023

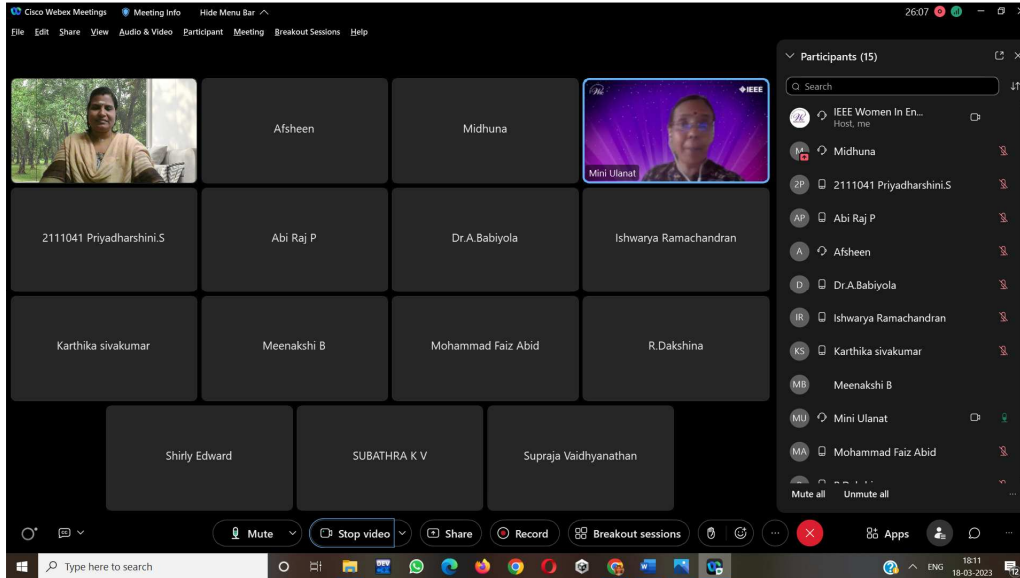

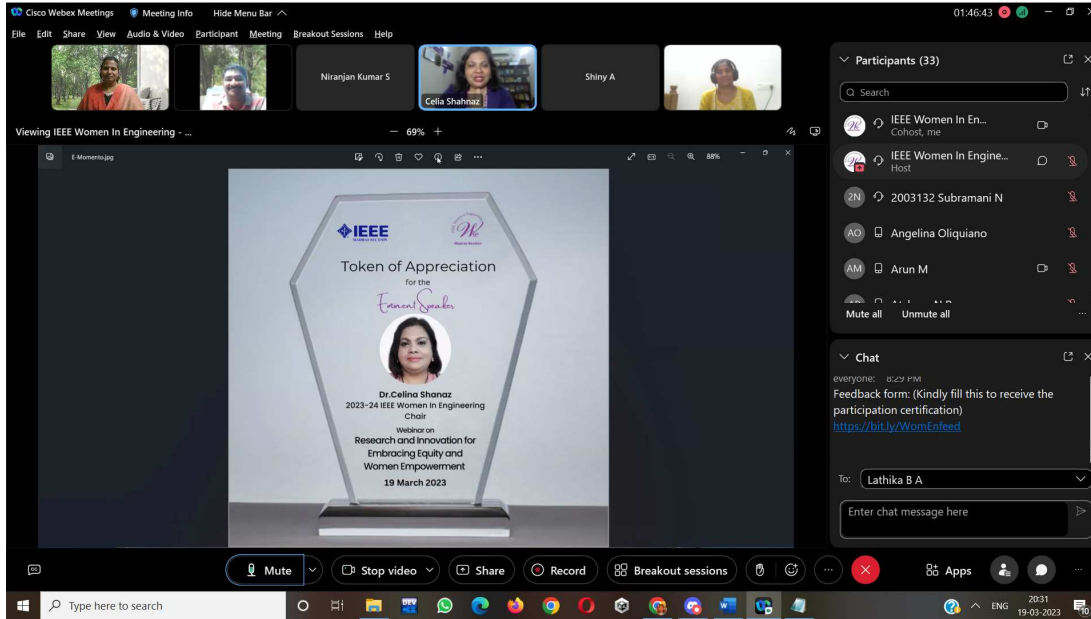
International Women's Day Webinar Series: IEEE WIE LeadX – Work Life Balance

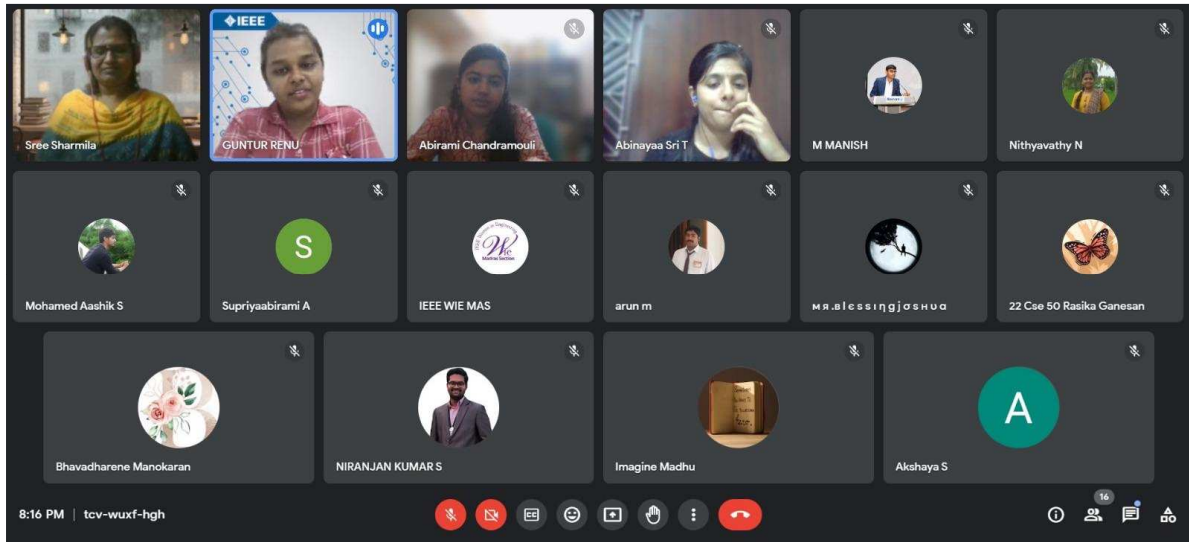


Empowering change: Panel talk with outstanding WIE volunteers

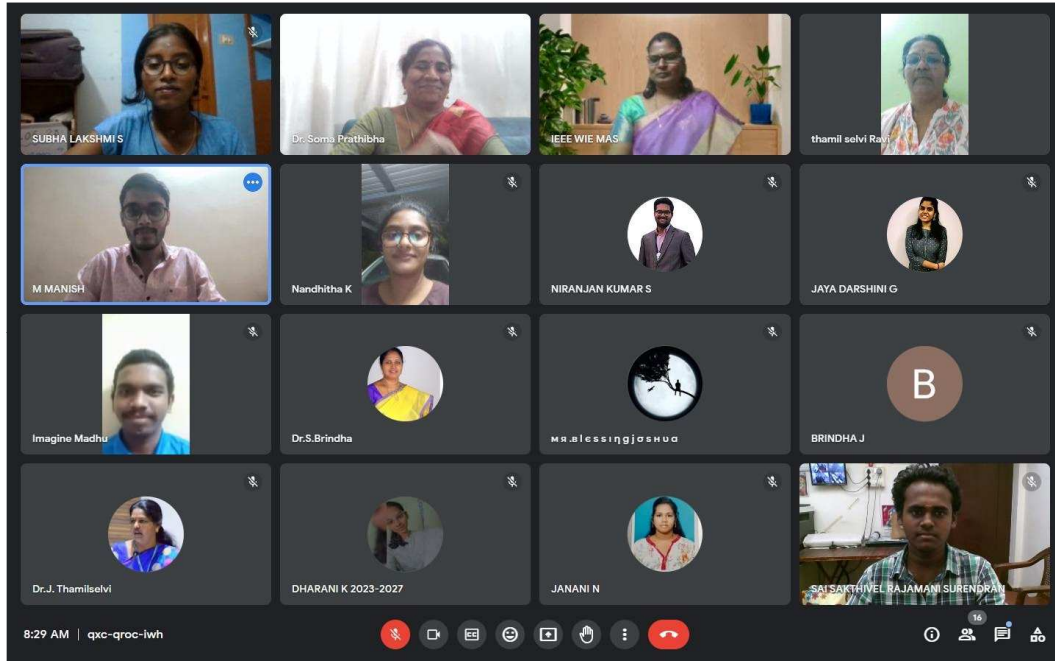

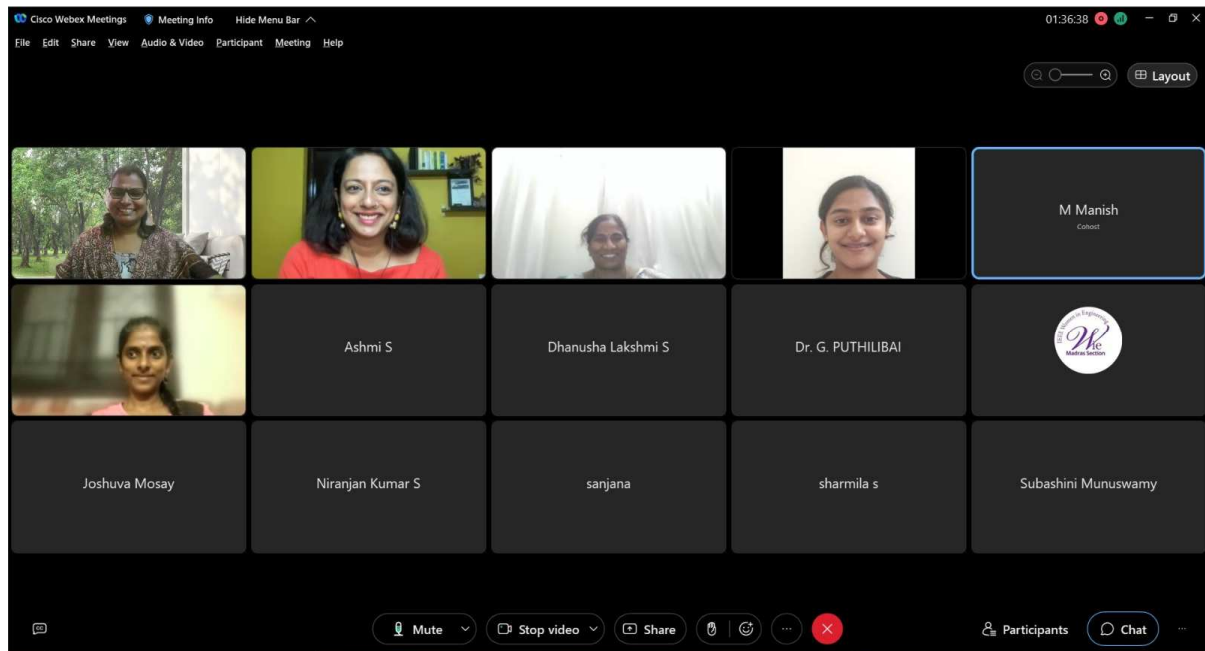

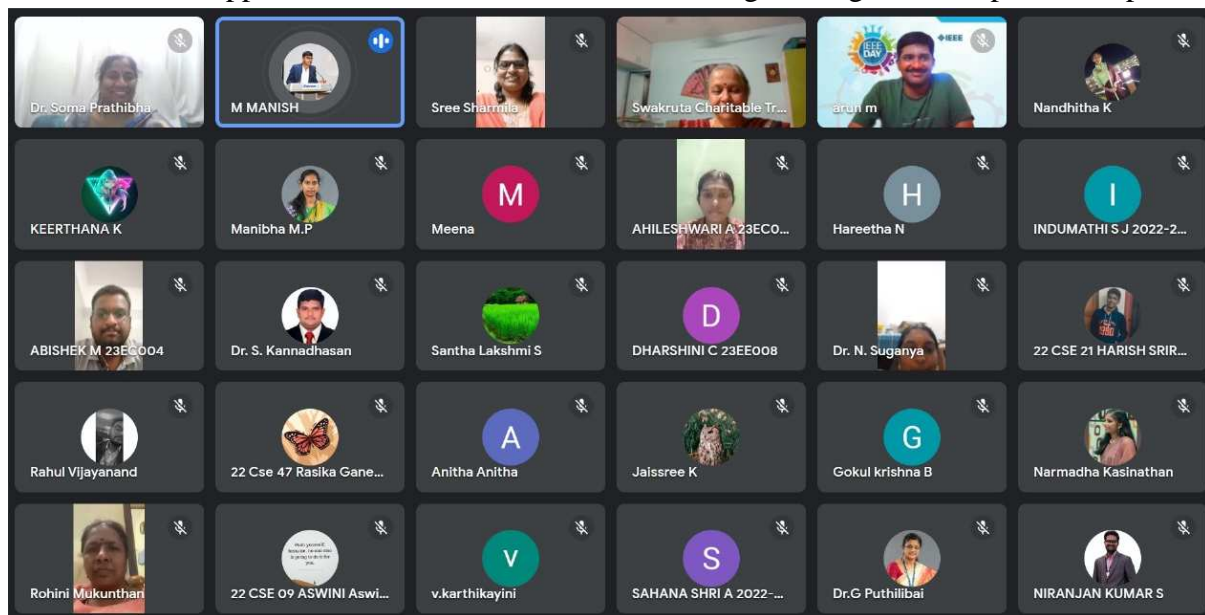
